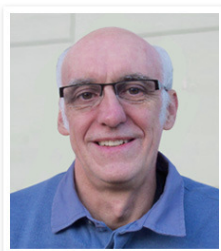

<b>Course aims</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>to help teachers to plan and teach Spanish to children in their first or second year of learning Spanish in Key Stage 2</li> <li>to help teachers to understand and meet the learning objectives for Years 3 and 4 in the Key Stage 2 Framework for Languages</li> <li>to demonstrate the use of resources such as authentic story books, audio CDs and DVDs</li> <li>to explore methodology suitable for teaching Spanish at word, sentence and text level</li> </ul>
